



Operating Hours– 7.30am to 6.00pm. Excursions leave at 9.30am sharp, unless advised otherwise. Please note – the only gate open for access is located on Hamilton Street (new the teacher’s car park).

Cost - \$57.00 per day (additional costs for excursions and clinics). Rozelle OOSH offers Childcare Benefit to registered families. Please see staff to discuss your entitlements.

Once you have booked your child in for care if you change your mind there are no refunds unless the place is "sold"

What to Bring – Your own morning tea and lunch, a water bottle, plus extra snacks (we are an allergy aware school and request no nut products). Breakfast and afternoon tea are provided. Children should be dressed comfortably for activities (e.g. shorts, t-shirt and closed in shoes **(no thongs or crocs)**). Children should also bring warm clothing. Don’t forget your hat and sunscreen. Remember – no hat, no play. **Make sure all items are clearly labelled.**

In-Centre Day Program – Activities run at the centre throughout the day with breaks for morning tea, lunch and afternoon tea. There is a detailed daily program located on the sign in/out table.

Important Information

Attendance – Rozelle Vacation Care is licensed for 150 children per day. The attendance can range from 75-130 dependent on the excursion venue, the program and availability.

Permission Notes – Excursions booked require an additional permission for to be signed and returned.

Staff to Child Ratios – Excursions 1:8 and In-Centre 1:15.

Statements – Please check your statements carefully for the date you have booked to ensure there are no errors.

Vacation Care First Aid Officers – Andrea Takoushis (Nominated Supervisor) and Susan Rigg (Authorised Supervisor). Most staff have first aid, anaphylaxis and asthma certificates.

Wet Weather – In the event of adverse weather conditions, staff will make the decision if a venue is still suitable. A similar alternative will be planned if necessary and where possible we will aim to inform parents on the day of any changes.
